





### A. Important Notes

# NOTE 1



All students without the right of abode/right to land in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) MUST apply for an HKSAR student visa for the purpose of education.



Students who use travel visa or travel endorsement to participate in any classes, tutorials and other academicrelated activities will be regarded as illegal.



It is the responsibility of individual students to make appropriate visa arrangements before they come to Hong Kong.

### **Processing Time**

It will take **6-8 weeks** (10-12 weeks during summer peak season) upon receipt of a complete set of application documents.

## **Application Fee**

- The Entry for Study visa application fee is **HK\$990**
- Our visa application system does NOT accept DEBIT CARD payment. Please pay with a CREDIT CARD (VISA, MASTER, UNIONPAY etc.)

## 1. ACCEPT CONDITIONAL/ FIRM OFFER



You can apply for Student Visa with a conditional or firm offer.

However, you will need your firm offer and confirm it to get your actual visa.

Visa Application fee: <u>HKD 990</u>

•If you apply via the local Chinese Embassy: <u>HKD 350</u> (applicants need to bear additional administration fees charged)

•If you decide to apply via the local Chinese embassy, you will need to handle the visa application on your own. HKU AO will provide a supporting letter to facilitate such the application

Please pay with **CREDIT CARD** (VISA, MASTER, UNIONPAY etc.) Debit card is NOT accepted.




Please note that student visa application via local Chinese Embassy is <u>NOT</u> <u>applicable</u> for:


- Students pursing part-time programmes
- Students pursing elective or short-term programmes
- Student holding a conditional offer
- Students from the mainland, Taiwan, Afghanistan, Cuba, Laos, Korea (Democratic People's Republic of), Nepal and Vietnam

For students with International Qualifications, submit the copy of signed firm offer letter ASAP



For copy of offer letter, screenshots are allowed



For students with multiple offers, choose your most desired major in visa application





# QUESTION 1



Q: When do I submit the application hard copies to Admission Office?

A: Please submit your online visa application via our system and the AO will cross check your uploaded documents with 5 working days.

**AFTER** your softcopies are checked, we will send you an email with our postal address to ask you to post the hard copies to HKU Admissions Office.

# QUESTION 2

香港大學 THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG Q: If I have 2 conditional offers from 2 different universities in HK, how can I apply for a student visa?

A: You have the option to apply for a student visa at different universities in Hong Kong. However, the Hong Kong Immigration Department requires you to **declare the specific programme** you intend to pursue before approving the visa.

# QUESTION 3

香港大學 THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG Q: If I wish to nominate HKU as my guardian, whose signature should I put on the "Guardian Nomination Form"?

A: Please ask your parent/guardian to sign the nomination form and tick the option of "HKU Representative". The AO will complete the "HKU representative/guardian" section after your submission.

# QUESTION 4



Q: I am still 17 years old but will turn 18 years old at the study commencement, do I need a guardian if I submit the application now?

A: Normally, you are not required to submit a guardian nomination letter if you will be 18 years old or above when you commence your studies.

\*However, the AO/HK ImmD may request you to submit the guardian form and birth certificate for reference.

# QUESTION 5



Q: I am renewing my passport during the visa application process, is it fine?

A: HK ImmD will approve your visa based on the passport validity you submit for the visa application.

If your passport validity period cannot cover the whole study duration, the approved duration will then <u>be shorter than your normal study</u> <u>duration</u>.

You need to bring both your old and new passports, together with the e-Visa, when entering HK. After you entered HK, you will have to apply for a visa extension about 6 weeks before your visa expiry.

# QUESTION 6



Q: How much deposit should I have in my bank account? Do you accept foreign currency?

A: Suggested amount: HK\$100,000-\$150,000 for one fullyear study (for reference only)

Foreign currency equivalent to the amount mentioned above is acceptable.

HK ImmD will do the final assessment.

# QUESTION 7

Q: Can I receive my visa before meeting the offer conditions?

A: No. You are required to upload your "Firm Offer" Letter onto the system (as proof of your eligibility to register at HKU). Otherwise, Admissions Office will not send the visa/entry permit to you.



# QUESTION 8



Q: If I am not able to fulfil the conditions of offers from HKU, can I change the visa application to another university?

A: No. Please submit another visa application with other universities, and please note that your visa application fee is non-refundable whether your visa application in HKU is successful or not.

# QUESTION 9

### Q: Can I enter Hong Kong to wait for a visa permit?

A: We do not suggest you come to Hong Kong first. You will be given a visitor permit and HK ImmD will ask you to leave and enter Hong Kong again to activate your student visa.



# QUESTION 10



Q: Can I study at HKU with a dependent visa/IANG visa/Top Talent Pass Scheme?

A: Yes. But please pay attention to your visa expiry and apply for a visa extension directly at HK ImmD within 6 weeks before such expiry date.

A: If you wish to switch to the student visa, you may submit your application 10-12 weeks before the expiry date.

# QUESTION 11



Q: Do I need to provide bank statements of my parents if I will support myself on daily expenses and tuition fee during my study in Hong Kong?

A: No. Please provide your latest (within 3 months) bank statement/financial aid/scholarship) with the suggested amount in your account.

# QUESTION 12

### Q: How can I receive the visa?

A: The HK ImmD has replaced the sticker-style labels for entry visa / permit with an electronic version of "Notification Slip for Entry Visa / Permit" ("e-Visa"). We will send you an email regarding the details of downloading your e-Visa in due course.



# QUESTION 13



#### Q: When will I get the e-Visa?

A: Your visa permit will be collected from HK ImmD and release to you in 5 working days after approval. You will receive the link for downloading the e-Visa via e-mail.

! However, we will not collect your student visa too early to ensure that it covers your entire study period.

For those who would admit in the new academic year (programme starts in Aug/Sep 2024), your visa permit will be collected from HK ImmD **from June/July 2024 onwards**.
